ARTS INCUBATION PROGRAMME

The 10 Square Youth Arts Incubation Programme is a specialised two-year arts training curriculum designed for youths aged 13 - 19 to expose them to the professional arts industry.

The programme offers an array of platforms for youths to perform in Singapore and internationally. We set the stage for our youths to showcase their talents in front of a live audience.



Year 1

During the first year, the programme imparts key strategies and techniques to enable students to conquer the stage and deliver heartfelt performances.

The core syllabus covers fundamental principles of performing arts – creating, preparing and presenting their works in a chosen genre. Students are encouraged to showcase their works through exhibitions, performances, and competitions.

Year 2

The Year 2 curriculum seeks to impart a deeper understanding of the chosen genre through industry insights shared by experienced artists and practitioners.

Students will pick up a range of technical and production skills through the execution of arts-related events (performances/exhibitions) that are integral in their pursuit of a career in the arts.
